IGB seeks assistance in identifying burglars

CHICAGO – (January 3, 2018) The Illinois Gaming Board is seeking the public's assistance in identifying two men suspected in carrying out several burglaries at video gaming establishments in central Illinois over the past few months. Persons with information on the suspects should call the IGB Video Gaming hotline at (855) 494-0237. Callers can remain anonymous.

The suspects have allegedly burglarized the video gaming redemption devices at several truck stops in Monee, Downs, Marion and O'Fallon Illinois. The redemption devices are being burglarized by two men, one who acts as a look-out and the other who breaks into the video gaming terminals and or redemption devices to remove the cash.

Both suspects are white males who were seen driving what appears to be a silver Pontiac Grand Prix (2004 to 2008). The burglaries occurred at the following locations:

- Powhatan Restaurant in Pocahantas, IL.
- Huck's Truck Stop #379 in Marion, IL
- Downs Travel Mart, Downs, IL
- Pilot Travel Center in Monee, IL.
